### Community Acquired Pneumonia, Adult - Inpatient

Fluoroquinolones, macrolides and β-lactams are effective for the treatment of community-acquired pneumonia. Despite limited evidence, experts recommend that patients with community-acquired pneumonia be given at least 1 antimicrobial to treat atypical pathogens.
